Brigid McCaw is the Medical Director for the Northern California Family Violence Prevention Program for Kaiser Permanente. She oversees the implementation of a coordinated approach for improving screening, identification, and services for intimate partner violence (IPV) and is also leading the national efforts of Kaiser Permanente to improve IPV services for over 8.5 million members, as well as 15,000 physicians, and 164,000 employees in 10 states.

This program has received several awards including the 2003 Gold HERA Award from American Association of Health Plans (AAHP) and the 2007 eValue8 Innovations Award from the National Business Coalition on Health.

She received her MS and MPH from UC Berkeley, and MD from UC San Francisco. She completed an Internal Medicine residency at UC Davis, was elected to Fellowship of the American College of Physicians.
